## The purpose of this Assembly is:

- [Interfaith small group members](#) build community in every group of which they are a part, and individually tend toward happiness or joy, which become their lifelong skills.
- The Corporation uses the [Loquate Turnkey](#) to build the social component of its ESG score. The lifelong skills carry over into the corporation.

## Agenda - 10 am to 10:50 am

Let us use the words interchangeably: God, or Spirit, or That which you value the most for the common good.

### **Is any person willing to be a focus person by sharing a concern they have about their handling of some God thing at work?**

Another person acts as [Facilitator](#): It will be ideal if 4 yeses: 1) Is this a concern you are facing now? 2) Is this a concern about changing yourself, as opposed to trying to change someone else? 3) Is this a question about faith and morals? 4) Is this a question about doing the right thing in the eyes of God?

## **1. Can any who faced a similar concern tell a resolution story?**

*Facilitator: gently guide participants out of giving advice into telling a story. A story uses I statements and permits dignity for all. Facilitator tip: When you most feel like saying something, call on another to share.*

## **2. What alternative or combination of alternatives does the focus person like best?**

*Facilitator: Does the focus person see the best practice as truly in the best interests of others? Can the focus person get the job done accomplishing the best practice? Will the focus person be operating in an area of meaningful expansion for themselves? If "yes" to all three the focus person will tend toward happiness or joy for himself and sense of community for every group of which the focus person is a part. The focus person will satisfy innate needs of relatedness, competence, and autonomy and will feel good. Shared experience makes a big difference.*
