Document every instance of trying to rewrite history by an authority person to a non authority person. Such documentation builds up a strong case of abuse by an advocate to a tribunal set up to restore truth. In America, mainstream news has been acting like those in Nazi history and blocking some good information that others put out. Objective, contextual truth is good news reporting. Such justice is unknown to many who find themselves with no place to turn. For example, in Nazi history<sup>1</sup> the Nazi's created 'positive Christianity.'

Particularly important here was the concept of 'positive Christianity' which for pseudo-religious motives, promised to develop a progressive religion appropriate to the time. The alternative to the traditional gospel was a self-made religious mix, whose aim was to create a new national church ruled by a worldly dictator. Hitler proclaimed 'positive Christianity to be the foundation of his political activity...

The "Guidelines" of the new faith movement stated: 'We see in race, Volkstum and nation a way of life given and entrusted to us by God [...] In particular, marriage between German and Jews is to be forbidden.' The prohibitions also ordered the exclusion of 'Jewish Christians', the 'deJewification of the church's message, through rejection of the Old Testament, reinterpretation of the New Testament, as well as 'keeping the German race pure' by 'protecting it from those who were "unacceptable" or "inferior."...'...

A counter-movement in the Protestant camp began when, in September 1933 in Berlin, the General Synod of the Evangelical Church of the Old Prussian Union

introduced the so-called Aryan paragraph'. This was accompanied by the forced retirement of all ministers and church officials, any of whose parents or grandparents were of Jewish stock...

On 10 February 1931 the (Catholic) Bavarian Bishop's Conference asserted that National Socialism was to be rejected...

But then came a dramatic about-turn... On 25 March 1933. Five days after Hitler's Government Statement, the Fulda and Fressing Bishop's Conferences issued a joint pastoral letter. The crucial statement in it read: "Without rescinding the condemnation of particular religious-moral errors expressed in our previous communications, the Episcopate believes that the aforementioned general prohibitions and warnings no longer need to be regarded as necessary... When it came, the German Catholic Bishops did not openly oppose Hitler's war or tell Catholics not to serve in the armed forces.

A terrible day and resounding slap in the face for Ratzinger senior, (the father of Joseph who in later years became Pope Benedict XVI), who declared that many of the Bishops had been lulled into acquiescence and deceived. 'On the one hand he was an incredibly pious man, who prayed often and was deeply rooted in the church's faith,' his son Joseph said, 'and at the same time he was a very austere, critical man, who could even be very critical of pope and bishops.' He added 'It was just that sober piety with which he practiced his faith and deeply imbued me, that was so important for me.'

War criminal tribunals were set up in Nazi history to restore the truth. The world is still reeling whenever whole segments of population are deprived of objective, contextual, truth as good news reporting.

According to Fr. Fred Kammer, SJ, in an article 9-16-2009 entitled Spirituality: Seeing the Divine in our Midst

“Spirituality is essentially about seeing God’s presence and activity in the midst of human reality. In a way, we look through or past the apparent object and event and see its inner self, trying to discern the movements of God’s grace and the opposing forces of evil, their interplay, and our own roles in the conflict.

### **Our media patron at Loquate.tv is St. Maximilian Kolbe.**

St. Maximilian, a Franciscan Friar, was born Raymond Kolbe in Poland on 1/8/1894. He began spreading consecration to Mary, like an army that he called the Militia of the Immaculata, a peaceful movement founded in 1917. He was sent to study in Rome where he was ordained a priest in 1918.

Father Maximilian returned to Poland in 1919. In 1927, near Warsaw, Poland he established the “City of the Immaculate.” By 1939, the City had expanded from eighteen friars to nearly 900, making it the largest Catholic religious house in the world.

To better “win the world for the Immaculata,” the friars utilized the most modern printing and administrative techniques. This enabled them to publish countless catechetical and devotional tracts, a daily newspaper with a circulation of 230,000 and a monthly magazine with a

circulation of over one million. Maximilian started a radio station and planned to build a motion picture studio—he was a true “apostle of the mass media.” He established other centers including in Nagasaki, Japan, in 1930 in a remote location behind a mountain. (The Japan location was protected when the atom bomb fell on Nagasaki.)

During World War II, his monastery in Poland continued to act as a publishing house, issuing a number of anti-Nazi German publications. He provided shelter to refugees, including something like 2,000 Jews alone whom he hid from German persecution in the friary. After his city was captured by the Germans, on 2/17/41 Kolbe and four others were arrested by the Gestapo. Continuing to act as a priest, Kolbe was subjected to violent harassment, including beating and lashings. He volunteered to die in place of a stranger in the German death camp of Auschwitz, located in German-occupied Poland.

According to an eyewitness, who was an assistant janitor at that time, in his prison cell Kolbe led the prisoners in prayer. Each time the guards checked on him, he was standing or kneeling in the middle of the cell and looking calmly at those who entered. After they had been starved and deprived of water for two weeks, only Kolbe remained alive.

When the guards wanted the bunker emptied, they gave Kolbe a lethal injection. Kolbe is said to have raised his left arm and calmly waited for the deadly injection. He died on 8/14/41.

His remains were cremated on 8/15/41, the feast day of the Assumption of Mary.

### **St. Maximilian Kolbe lived the Perfect Law of Freedom.**

## Explanation of Surrender to God
