I paid my respects and was on the alert, pausing, looking, but seeing no one that I knew. My antennae were up. I walked to the center aisle and saw a friendly face. I slipped into the pew next to Nancy Nugent.

I turned to Nancy and said I was here under very unusual circumstances. Before I could say anything more, Nancy blurted out “You are here under very unusual circumstances! Listen to this! I was walking home and the Blessed Mother said: Go back! Go back! So I came back here.”

Then I explained about the message I received from the Blessed Mother at her lit up white statue. Nancy and I became friends.

Nancy met with me several times and explained the Marian Movement of Priests

and interpretation of Fr. Gobbi’s messages. They all related to me. I will forever be grateful to Nancy.

Then my spiritual advisor, Fr. Peter Gnoinski was transferred to St Ferdinand as its Pastor. He and I look out the window and marvel at the Blessed Mother crushing the head of Satan in the white, lit up statue next to the rectory. Then Fr. Peter on 10/19/22 asked Nancy and I to kick off his event Miracles, First Hand in the upper room, the Chapel at 3117 N Mason Ave!

Sequel

My brother James P. Liautaud died October 23, 2015 (aged 79) about 1 year after Patricia Wenzl died. Because of Rich I have a great devotion to Divine mercy.

The song, Amazing Grace, that you heard in the video My Brother, Jim was from the lady in the hospital. Her name is Yolanda --- And she did sing at Jim's funeral. It happened like this.

Jim's son, Jimmy John, texted me just before the service. I told him about the lady singer. He flew her by private jet to Jim's home in northern Wisconsin.

After the service I asked Yolanda how she came to sing at the funeral. She said she was at home praying: God give me something new to do. The doorbell rang. A man said he wanted to fly me someplace in a private jet to sing at a funeral.

"After the man left, I said Lord, what do you want me to do? The Lord answered me: 'You wanted to do something different. Go ahead.'"

That is amazing grace.

By reconnecting with Jim I was blessed in a way that no other way could have worked. My understanding of Spirit-centered community has evolved over time to include every person on earth thru academic research. It is true that it began inside my Work Meets Faith Small group.

Miracle 4 - Guidance 11/15/16 diary jtl

According to my diary, one month after Pat Wenzl's wake, I was given the following as guidance.

I commit to be anchored with you in my Work Meets Faith small group. I commit to seeing Christ in you and in each person in my small group. Being anchored means permanently being anchored. My charismatic cross is suffering for you, as Christ suffered for me. The mystery is this.

As I learn to love and live thru my small group I learn to love and live with every human soul. I evolve into

God's loving act of abundant life for all in all. Unless I am in a virtuous permanent union with you, I cannot rest as God the Father intended from all eternity. I seek to evolve into God's loving act of abundant life for all in all. There is a level of intimacy only permitted thru deep lifelong commitment, as a married couple makes to each other, even suffering at the hands of each other like Christ suffered for us, and like every married couple and every family suffers for each other. That commitment permits risking of the deepest kind, the kind that Jehovah took before time.

The risk that God took was that God gave each of His created beings free will. Free will means free will even to leave God. Leaving God is sin.

We are all flawed. Satan would have us leave "the flawed." Then the accuser would turn on us and accuse us of "being flawed." Satan is the accuser. We are mistaken if we believe we can see Christ in each other, any other, only part of the time. Our eyes are open only when we love and see Christ in every person who like myself is flawed.

We cheat ourselves and we cheat others by lack of commitment to stay with each other no matter what. Therefore, I tell you that I commit myself to you and to our Work Meets Faith small group no matter what. Divine intimacy pierces the veil of deception of Satan that any person could ever be perfect. Therefore, I tell you, I will never leave you, no matter what.

Think of a brick that comprises a humble home, an ordinary house brick. Well, that brick turns to purest gold in the eyes of Christ who sees us when we commit to each other, as Christ committed himself to us for the Father even dying on a cross for us, the only place where Satan cannot be present, that divine spark of God centered self emptying sense of community, the spark to be with each other in the name of Jesus in a personal divine fire of suffering for another one of us in our Work Meets Faith small group when they leave us. And divine intimacy comes in no other way except thru this deep commitment, like God has made to us.
